



As we close out the year, I am amazed at all the progress that Ohio START has made during 2019. This year, we added 14 additional counties to the program, bringing the total number of counties participating in Ohio START to 46, brought the total number of clients served to over 900 individuals (as of middle of September) with more than 500 of those being children, Ohio START was the recipient of an Addiction Policy Forum Innovation Now award, held our first annual Ohio START Summit in June, gathering Ohio START programs from all counties for the first time and restructured our technical assistance program. Before the end of the year, we will release case screening criteria guidance, a new and improved implementation guide and provide training on hiring and onboarding family peer mentors. What a busy and great year it has been! I cannot wait to see what 2020 brings. Have a great holiday season.

Kent State is Using Data to Predict Substance Use Trends

Researchers from Kent State University received a grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) to create a data analytics system that can predict drug and alcohol epidemics before they happen.

The program will combine data from a number of sources including social media and hospital records.

Researchers are currently using data from Portage, Geauga, and Lake Counties, but hope to include more counties in the future.
