Fayette County Family Peer Mentor Kerri Black recently celebrated 8 years of sobriety surrounded by her coworkers at Fayette County Child Protective Services.

Kerri Black applied to be a family peer mentor because she wanted to give back by offering lived experience and understanding to her clients. In her time with Fayette County Child Protective Services, Black has seen changes in both her clients and the overall community culture. "People get burnt out and don't understand. They see the same people over and over again. But now that I've been there and they celebrated my eight years of recovery, it's getting better."

One of the most rewarding parts of her job is getting clients into treatment and seeing them progress in their recovery. Black recently ran into an acquaintance who told her that they had been offered drugs but had said no. Hearing that "made [her] so happy. One day at a time."

When asked if she had any tips for someone struggling with substance use, she stressed the importance of a support system. "You have to get a support system. It's crucial. You need someone to hold you accountable."

Becoming a family peer mentor has given Black an opportunity to become part of that support system for others. "I feel like I'm finally doing what I'm meant to do in life."
